



One-on-One Instrumental Music Programme with Pure Orchestral Centre Academic Year 2025-2026

Since the school's establishment in 2014, music has been an exciting and integral part of life at NAISHK, and to further enhance our curriculum, we offer a full range of 1:1 instrumental tuition at our campus.

This service is run in conjunction with Pure Orchestral Centre, a well-established music service since 1997, which caters for beginning students through to advanced players. Lessons are available in 30 or 60 minute sessions, the time of which takes place during the school hours, and is rotated to avoid missing the same lesson each week.

Instrumental lessons are available on:

The 1:1 instrumental lessons are supported by a full extra-curricular programme, which includes a variety of ensembles including bands, orchestras and choirs. We expect our 1:1 instrumental students to join at least one of these ensembles to help develop their general musicianship and gain further enjoyment from their learning. Additionally, being a part of one of these ensembles guarantees the ability to play in our various concerts held throughout the year.

Through this programme, students are also encouraged to:

1. Take an Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music (ABRSM) practical examination with the support of their instrumental teacher. ABRSM is the world's leading provider of music exams, offering assessments to over 600,000 candidates in over 90 countries every year. ABRSM's mission is to inspire achievement in music. In partnership with the Royal Schools of Music, the examinations support high-quality music-making and help build musical skills, provide goals and encourage progress.
2. Take part in the annual Hong Kong Schools' Music Festival or/and other regional or international music competitions
3. Participate in school concerts and year-round performances
4. Create performance(s) and share within the NAISHK school's community (and/or public) via social media channels



Lesson fees will be billed termly by **Pure Orchestral Centre**. Students who have previously participated in the programme or are currently preparing for their ABRSM examinations will be given priority for enrollment.
